Important Notification

EDIUS 8 requires SHA-2 hash algorithm code signing for Grass Valley hardware driver installation. All versions of Windows 7 and Windows 8 / 8.1 already support SHA-2 code signing, but if you are running Windows 7, you will need to install Security Updates.

SHA-2 code signing requires the installation of TWO Security Updates on Windows 7 in order to install Grass Valley hardware.

They MUST be installed in the following order:

1. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3035131\)](#)
2. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3033929\)](#)

If they have not been installed, EDIUS installer will ask you to install the security updates.

Update History

The following issues are fixed or improved in this version:

EDIUS

- EDIUS freezes if the timeline is exported to XAVC Intra Class 100 with segment encoding.
- If H.264/AVC file export is registered to a batch export job, the exported clip is corrupted.
- EDIUS installer now stops if Windows security updates for SHA-2 code signing have not been installed.
- EDIUS installer skips the DirectX Runtime installation if the same Runtime version has already been installed.
- EDIUS displays a 12-bit DPX clip with incorrect color.
- If a Gaussian Blur filter is applied, it may take an unacceptably long time to export the file on a PC that supports the AVX instruction set.
- Quick Sync Video accelerated encode for H.264/AVC file export does not work in certain cases.
- EDIUS asks for the serial number even if the license has already been activated.
- If large font size is selected in Windows display settings, the drop-down item is displayed in a larger size than the menu bar item.
- If large font size is selected in Windows display settings, the folder pane close button in the Bin window is indistinct.
- If both EDIUS Pro 8 Trial and Upgrade licenses are activated, the trial license takes precedence over the upgrade license.
- If the EDIUS Pro 8 Trial Version is activated, the trial expiration term still appears even if the product license is subsequently activated.
- If an in-point is set at the top of timeline, dragging that in-point to reposition it is not easy.
- Cannot deactivate EDIUS license if you do not have administrator rights.
- If you click the 'No' button to cancel the registration of a Layouter preset, the confirmation

dialog reappears.

- Display order of effect icons can be changed, even if the effect tree is locked.

GV Browser

- GV Browser crashes if AVCHD and XAVC S clips are repeatedly imported.
- FTP upload cannot be cancelled.
- A clip that has been registered is detected as registration target.
- GV Browser crashes if a catalog that contains an off-line clip is exported as XML.
- GV Browser freezes if another folder is selected while a clip is being registered.
- GV Browser crashes or freezes when quitting the GV Browser application.
- GV Browser crashes if an authorization code is copied and pasted by mouse while registering a Vimeo account in GV Browser.
- A clip that is registered to a library does not contain metadata.
- Auto-complete is now available for easily editing clip properties (camera maker, model number and creator).

Known Issues

Another EDIUS ID can be registered

Description: If an EDIUS ID is created and an EDIUS serial key is activated and attached to that ID, and another optional serial key is subsequently added (for example, a DNxHD license), it is possible to manually change the EDIUS ID at that point. This is a design flaw in the system – you should NOT change the EDIUS ID, because this will confuse the GV License Manager and EDIUS will not start.
