Important Notification

EDIUS 8 requires SHA-2 hash algorithm code signing for Grass Valley hardware driver installation. All versions of Windows 7 and Windows 8 / 8.1 already support SHA-2 code signing, but if you are running Windows 7, you will need to install Security Updates.

SHA-2 code signing requires the installation of TWO Security Updates on Windows 7 in order to install Grass Valley hardware.

They MUST be installed in the following order:

1. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3035131\)](#)
2. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3033929\)](#)

If they have not been installed, EDIUS installer will ask you to install the security updates.

New Features of Version 8.20.312

This update provides the following additional features:

- Primary color correction (RGB) on LOG or RAW clips.
- Motion tracking feature for Mask filter.
- Support for RAW decoding. (Sony and Canon RAW supported)
- Support for draft video preview. (EDIUS Workgroup only)
- Support for importing new Panasonic P2 AVC-Ultra formats (Intra422, Intra LT and Intra LT 2K).
- Support for browsing external folder in Sony XDCAM Station V3.0. (EDIUS Workgroup only)
- Connectivity to K2 storage via FTP without K2 Connect Option. (EDIUS Workgroup only)
- Support for Dolby-E or AC3 audio pass-through output for XDCAM MXF clip. (EDIUS Workgroup only)
- Support for handling still images as a sequence in GV Browser.
- Find duplicate clips in the GV Browser library .
- Draft preview to browse registered clips in GV Browser.
- GPX file import in GV Browser.

Update History

The following issues are fixed or improved in this version:

EDIUS

- EDIUS crashes while editing on the timeline if Blackmagic Design hardware is used as the preview device. (SFDC00475853)
- Incorrect timecode information is saved with a captured clip if video is captured in XDCAM MXF-compatible format. (SFDC00506274) (EDIUS Workgroup only)

- Keyboard shortcut that is assigned for [View] > [Pause Field] is inverted between upper and lower fields. (SFDC00513071)
- EDIUS takes a long time to display the [Tools] menu.
- GV License Manager is still running in the Windows Task Manager even if it fails to start.
- Edge of clip is displayed incorrectly if 3D Dissolve effect is applied in a 10-bit project.
- EDIUS crashes if a corrupt AVC-Intra clip is loaded.
- EDIUS freezes if a clip mixer transition is trimmed.
- Sequence marker cannot be deleted by using [Del] key.

GV Browser

- GV Browser plays video clip slowly.
- GV Browser takes a long time to display a clip in full-screen preview if many clips are registered.
- A clip in "All Clips" remains selected if the clip is selected in the EDIUS Source Browser and context menu chosen [Show in GV Browser]
- Off-line video clip appears in the catalog without off-line icon.
- A clip is sometimes not registered to favorites if the star mark is clicked in full-screen preview.
- Audio scratch noise appears while playing certain video clips.
- Clip sort order is reset to Date Taken if folder is selected, then All Clips selected.
- Catalog selection is not preserved if GV Browser is restarted.
- Full-screen video clip playback sometimes does not stop.
- Zebra unexpectedly appears even though playing audio clip.
- Some keyboard shortcuts do not work if Caps Lock is enabled on keyboard.
