## Important

EDIUS 8 requires SHA-2 hash algorithm code signing for Grass Valley hardware driver installation. All versions of Windows 7 and Windows 8 / 8.1 and 10 already support SHA-2 code signing, but if you are running Windows 7, you will need to install Security Updates.

SHA-2 code signing requires the installation of TWO Security Updates on Windows 7 in order to install Grass Valley hardware.

They MUST be installed in the following order:

1. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3035131\)](#)
2. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3033929\)](#)

If they have not been installed, EDIUS installer will ask you to install the security updates.

## New Features of Version 8.30.1233

*This update provides the following additional features:*

### **EDIUS**

- Timecode display on Bin clips in tile view.
- Video resolution presets larger than 2K for printing to file with format conversion.
- Display XDCAM clips in the Source Browser in same order as Sony Content Browser.
- Optical flow option for slow motion video.
- Ability to select proxy clip resolution.
- EDIUS additionally supports several DNxHD MXF formats for import / export (DNxHD option required for EDIUS Pro 8).
- F-Log color space support for source / destination in primary color correction.
- Disc Burner supports burn to disc for various project formats.

### **GV Browser**

- Display container format name in clip properties.
- Take snapshot in preview window.
- Select more locations for OSD item.
- Favorites folder contains Desktop as factory default.

## Update History

*The following issues are fixed or improved in this version:*

### **EDIUS**

- Editing text unexpectedly changes font size in Quick Titler. (SFDC00523696)
- Off-line hash is not drawn when loading FCP XML. (SFDC00475853)
- Cannot select 17<sup>th</sup> or later menu item button(s) in DVD burned by Disc Burner. (SFDC00536066)
- Applying audio normalize makes proxy clip off-line. (SFDC00537370)
- Cannot operate loudness meter dialog while playing clip. (EDIUS Workgroup only)
- Draft video preview still enabled even if new project is started. (EDIUS Workgroup only)
- Slightly magenta color shift occurs in Primary Color Correction.
- Primary Color Correction shows different color in draft video preview mode. (EDIUS Workgroup only)
- Menu design is reset if movie is added and auto layout enabled in Disc Burner.
- EDIUS opens another auto-saved project for project recover.
- An error occurs when printing the timeline to tape.

## GV Browser

- 'Choose Program' hides behind full-screen preview window.
- Over 100% progress appears if over 4GB clip is imported from a device that is connected by Windows Portable Device mode.
- Clip folder structure unexpectedly changes while importing an XAVC S clip.
- Takes a long time to pause still image sequence playback.
- GV Browser does not import JPEG data when importing RAW+JPEG clip.
- GV Browser does not detect imported clip as XF or XF-AVC when browsing imported XF or XF-AVC folder.
- Cannot register a clip from optical disc media.
- GV Browser crashes if language setting is changed.
- Windows Task Bar does not appear if GV Browser runs in full-screen mode.

## Design Limitations

### Restrictions after Uninstallation of QuickTime for Windows

The following functionality will be lost if QuickTime is uninstalled:

**Still Image File Formats:** Flash Pix; Mac Pict; QuickTime Image

**MOV Video File Formats:** 3GP; 3G2; M4V or some MOV file formats

**Audio File Formats:** MOV (other than Linear PCM and AAC); QuickTime Audio

### Exporting AAF Files

In the [Project Exporter (AAF)] dialog box, selecting [Type: 1] in [Preset] exports files in AVI (Grass Valley HQ) instead of QuickTime (H.264).
