Important Notification

EDIUS 8 requires SHA-2 hash algorithm code signing for Grass Valley hardware driver installation. All versions of Windows 7 and Windows 8 / 8.1 already support SHA-2 code signing, but if you are running Windows 7, you will need to install Security Updates.

SHA-2 code signing requires installation of Windows 7 updates in order to use Grass Valley hardware. There are following two ways to support SHA-2 code signing:

Obtain the latest update (recommended)

Obtain the latest update from Windows Update

Install two security updates

Install TWO Security Updates on Windows 7. Download stand-alone installer files from Microsoft website then run the installer. They MUST be installed in the following order.

1. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3035131\)](#)
2. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3033929\)](#)

If they have not been installed, EDIUS installer will ask you to install the security updates.

New Features of Version 8.32.1697

This update provides the following additional features:

EDIUS

- Support displaying Acquisition Metadata of XAVC/S, XDCAM or Sony RAW that is loaded into EDIUS Bin

Mync

- Product name changed from GV Browser to Mync.
- Storyboard function for cut editing and creating simple video sequence (created storyboard can be placed onto EDIUS timeline as sequence clip)
- Support to upload to Facebook.
- Displaying information board to notify myncworld.com web site update.

Update History

The following issues are fixed or improved in this version:

EDIUS

- Preview quality should be full-quality when pausing video in ECW (Effect Control Window) (only Workgroup 8).
- Disc Burner crashes while encoding for H.264 BD burning.
- Placed clip becomes off-line in certain clip copy steps.
- EDIUS cannot decode H.263 clip correctly. (SFDC00553008)
- Disc Burner creates incorrect folder to store menu style.

- EDIUS crashes with Layouter zoom from 0% and Bezier.
- Unnecessary line appears at edge of text in .psd clip. (SFDC00558089)
- EDIUS allows to load a project which contains odd channel wav file. (SFDC00565158)

Mync

- Audio level meter cannot use when playing audio clip.
- Window preview does not preserve audio volume adjusted in full-screen mode.
- Removable device cannot eject if stored movie is being loaded.
- Snapshot does not work once you select a destination where a file cannot be saved.

Known Issues

Mync displays low quality picture for small frame size picture

When browsing small frame size still images in Mync, displayed picture quality will be low.

Certain context menu items are not available in Mync

If a clip is previewed in full-screen mode on multiple monitors environment and you right-click on multiple selected clips, 'Set as Sequence' and 'Edit Properties' context menu are invisible.

Design Limitations

Restrictions after Uninstallation of QuickTime for Windows

The following functionality will be lost if QuickTime is uninstalled:

Still Image File Formats: Flash Pix; Mac Pict; QuickTime Image

MOV Video File Formats: 3GP; 3G2; M4V or some MOV file formats

Audio File Formats: MOV (other than Linear PCM and AAC); QuickTime Audio

Exporting AAF Files

In the [Project Exporter (AAF)] dialog box, selecting [Type: 1] in [Preset] exports files in AVI (Grass Valley HQ) instead of QuickTime (H.264).

Mync crashes if monitor cable is connected while running

Mync crashes if a monitor cable is connected while running the Mync then click view mode button.

Connect monitor cable before starting Mync.
